



**A highlight of Pharmacy crimes solved with the help of 3SI's GPS tracking technology.**

Amount Recovered	Summary
\$16,206	<p><b>Cherry Hill, NJ - Dec 27</b> Three suspects robbed a pharmacy in the early morning hours and fled on the interstate at speeds in excess of 102 mph before becoming stationary at a residence. When police from multiple agencies moved in to surround the area, the suspects fled again. State troopers conducted a high-risk stop and two of the suspects were taken into custody. The third suspect, with the bag of stolen narcotics, attempted to flee on foot but was apprehended by police. A full recovery was made.</p>
Full Recovery	<p><b>Sacramento, CA - Nov 29</b> Two suspects robbed a pharmacy of narcotics and fled by vehicle. Police were silently alerted and tracked with GPS. Both suspects were apprehended and a full recovery was made.</p>
\$44,000	<p><b>Annapolis, MD - Nov 29</b> Two armed suspects entered a pharmacy, demanded narcotics and fled with 55 bottles. PharmaTracker silently alerted police. Using GPS, police recovered the suspects' vehicle and the bag with the stolen narcotics. A full recovery was made and one suspect was taken into custody.</p>
\$12,000	<p><b>St. Paul, MN - Nov 6</b> A suspect armed with a fake handgun demanded OxyContin from a pharmacist. The pharmacist handed 15 bottles to the suspect who then fled on foot to an alley where he hid the narcotics and changed his clothes. <b>Police tracked and used the handheld beacon to pinpoint the exact location of the hidden narcotics. All the narcotics, gun, and clothes used in the robbery were recovered. The suspect is being held on \$100,000 bond.</b></p>
\$20,000	<p><b>St. Paul, MN - Oct 9</b> Suspect entered pharmacy and demanded narcotics. PharmaTracker immediately alerted police who quickly tracked and apprehended the suspect. All the narcotics were recovered.</p>
\$3,910	<p><b>Baltimore, MD - Oct 9</b> Four suspects robbed a pharmacy of narcotics and fled by vehicle. Police tracked with GPS and when the suspects became stationary on the side of the road, police moved in. The suspects then attempted to flee on foot. All the narcotics were recovered inside the car and the four suspects were apprehended.</p>



# GPS TRACKING

<i>Amount Recovered</i>	<i>Summary</i>
<b>\$24,000</b>	<b>Smithtown, NY - Aug 29</b> Two recovering heroin addicts robbed three pharmacies within 30 minutes. <i>The last pharmacy they robbed was protected by PharmaTracker. When they fled with 30 bottles in their possession, police were automatically notified and within minutes had the suspects in custody. All the narcotics were recovered. The two are facing felony robbery and attempted robbery charges.</i>
<b>\$20,000</b>	<b>Escondido, CA - Aug 2</b> A lone male suspect entered a pharmacy, threatened a weapon, and jumped the pharmacy counter. He then filled his backpack with Prometh bottles and fled. Police used GPS to track the suspect to an apartment complex where he became stationary. A handheld beacon was used by police to pinpoint the stolen narcotics and apprehend the suspect.
<b>Full Recovery</b>	<b>San Jacinto, CA - Jul 28</b> Police were alerted when PharmaTracker started moving away from a pharmacy. Within minutes of the robbery, police had the suspect vehicle pulled over. Before searching the vehicle, police chirped the Tracker to confirm that the stolen product was in the vehicle. Both suspects were taken into custody and all the narcotics were recovered.
<b>\$20,000</b>	<b>Baltimore, MD - Jul 22</b> A suspect robbed a pharmacy of narcotics and fled. <i>The local dispatchers had recently been trained on 3SI's GPS tracking and helped police quickly track and apprehend the suspect. All the narcotics were recovered and the suspect was apprehended.</i>
<b>\$20,000</b>	<b>La Plata, MD - Jun 9</b> Two armed suspects entered a pharmacy and forced a clerk to open the safe. The suspects then fled into a getaway car driven by a third suspect. Police tracked and a car chase ensued. The suspects crashed their car into a house and then attempted to flee on foot. All three suspects were apprehended and all the narcotics were recovered.
<b>\$16,000</b>	<b>Pickerington, OH - Jun 7</b> Two suspects robbed a pharmacy and fled with 20 bottles of narcotics. Police tracked and when the suspects became stationary in a hotel parking lot, police moved in and utilized the handheld beacon to pinpoint the suspect's exact location. One suspect was taken into custody and all the narcotics were recovered.
<b>Full Recovery</b>	<b>St. John's, NL - May 18</b> A male suspect armed with a knife demanded narcotics from a pharmacist. The pharmacist handed over pill bottles and the suspect fled. PharmaTracker immediately went to work and alerted police who tracked and apprehended the suspect. All the narcotics were recovered.

<b>Amount Recovered</b>	<b>Summary</b>
<b>Full Recovery</b>	<b>London, ON - May 13</b> Two armed male suspects entered a pharmacy, demanded narcotics and threatened to shoot the pharmacist. They then fled with multiple packs of Fentanyl patches. Police tracked, and when the suspects became stationary, they moved in. <b>The suspects had crashed their vehicle. Both suspects were apprehended and taken to the hospital with serious injuries.</b>
<b>\$20,000</b>	<b>Charleston, WV - May 6</b> Four repeat robbers are in custody after attempting to rob a pharmacy protected by PharmaTracker. <b>The four are Crip gang members from the Indianapolis area and have robbed at least 60 pharmacies in Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky, and West Virginia. All the narcotics were recovered.</b>
<b>\$20,000</b>	<b>Freedom, CA - Apr 17</b> Lone suspect held up a pharmacist and made off with a bag full of stolen narcotics. The suspect traveled a long distance before becoming stationary. Police tracked and apprehended the suspect. All the narcotics were recovered.
<b>\$29,600</b>	<b>Madison, WI - Mar 31</b> Suspect robbed a pharmacy of 36 bottles of Oxycodone. Police tracked and apprehended the suspect. All the narcotics were recovered.
<b>\$20,000</b>	<b>Maryville, TN - Mar 20</b> Suspect entered pharmacy, demanded narcotics and fled. GPS enabled police to track and apprehend the suspect. All the narcotics were recovered.
<b>\$12,600</b>	<b>London, ON - Feb 8</b> Two disguised males, one armed with a handgun, forced a pharmacist to open the store safe and then exited the pharmacy with a large quantity of narcotics. Police tracked with GPS. Both suspects are in custody and all the narcotics were recovered.
<b>\$20,000</b>	<b>Indianapolis, IN - Jan 11</b> Three suspects demanded narcotics from a pharmacist and traveled a good distance away from the pharmacy before becoming stationary in a parking lot. <b>Police tracked, apprehended the three suspects and recovered the vehicle with all the stolen narcotics inside.</b>
<b>Full Recovery</b>	<b>Minneapolis, MN - Jan 4</b> Suspect demanded narcotics from a pharmacist. Police tracked a long distance before the suspect came to a stop. Police moved in and apprehended the suspect and recovered all the narcotics inside the vehicle.
