| Amount | Summary |
|-------------------------------------|--|
| \$800 1 arrest | Pharma Tracker® - Corinth, ME - Dec 29 A suspect robbed a local pharmacy of narcotics at gunpoint and then fled. Cash Tracker alerted police who used GPS to locate the individual. All of the stolen merchandise was recovered and the suspect was captured. |
| \$42,310 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - San Dimas, CA - Dec 6 Three suspects robbed a pharmacy of narcotics and fled. Police tracked the suspects through several jurisdictions. Once the car became stationary they moved in and captured two of the three individuals involved. A search is still underway for the third suspect. A full recovery was made. |
| \$20,000 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - St Anthony, MN - November 11 Two suspects robbed a local pharmacy of drugs and a PharmaTracker at gunpoint. The responding police, following the tracking data, stopped the suspect's vehicle just a short while later. Both suspects were apprehended and all of the stolen drugs were recovered and kept off of the streets. |
| \$500 4 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Buffalo, NY - November 4 Four suspects robbed a big-box pharmacy of drugs and a Pharma Tracker. The tracker alerted police, who were logged into the 3SI website and tracking. Police used tracking data from the device to locate the suspects just a few miles from the scene of the crime. The suspects were apprehended and all of the drugs were returned to the pharmacy. |
| \$8,000 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Lincoln, NE - November 2 A suspect entered a large pharmacy and stole drugs and a PharmaTracker. The tracker alerted police who were logged in and tracking. The suspect was tracked to a local apartment building where he was apprehended just eight minutes later. All of the drugs were recovered. |
| \$10,237 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Dublin, OH - November 2 A suspect robbed a big-box pharmacy of drugs and a Pharma Tracker. The tracker quickly notified police. The suspect was stopped just steps away from the scene of the crime and apprehended. All of the drugs were returned to the pharmacy and kept off of the streets. |

| \$8,000 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Solvang, CA - October 31 Multiple suspects burglarized a closed pharmacy, stealing opioids and a Pharma Tracker. The device's tracking data helped police to locate the vehicle and a chase ensued. The suspects sped off into another jurisdiction and stopped in front of the local police department where one suspect was apprehended. All of the stolen drugs were returned to the pharmacy. |
| \$60,197 3 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Bellevue, NE - October 30 Three male suspects robbed a pharmacy. Two entered the store with a handgun while the third remained in the getaway car. The two suspects zip-tied a customer and three employees. The pharmacist was forced to open the safe where the suspects emptied its contents. The tracker activated and police responded, stopping the suspects a short distance away. A full recovery of the stolen drugs was made along with the handgun. |
| \$8,000 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Bellevue, NE - October 28 Two suspects robbed a pharmacy of a large amount of drugs, primarily OxyContin. They quickly fled, but police were on their trail. The vehicle eventually became stationary and the suspects were captured and charged. All of the stolen drugs were recovered. |
| \$8,000 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Englewood, OH - October 15 Two suspects robbed a local pharmacy and stole drugs and a PharmaTracker. The tracker immediately notified police. The suspects were apprehended. All of the stolen drugs were recovered and kept off the streets. |
| \$20,000 | PharmaTracker® - Indianapolis, IN - October 8 A suspect robbed a pharmacy for a large quantity of drugs and a Pharma Tracker. Police started tracking the device until it became stationary. The assailants, afraid of capture, abandoned their car and the stolen items. A full recovery was made. |
| \$20,000 | PharmaTracker® - Agoura Hills, CA - September 27 Multiple suspects wearing hats to disguise their identity entered a drug store and stole a large amount of drugs. They fled in a vehicle and headed towards South Central Los Angeles. Due to heavy highway traffic, police had difficulty identifying the suspects' vehicle. Luckily, other nearby officers identified the car and followed them. The suspects spotted the tail, discarded all of the stolen drugs and escaped. The suspects were not apprehended but all of the stolen narcotics were recovered and kept off the streets. |
| \$20,000 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Crofton, MD - September 20 Five suspects implied weapons and robbed a pharmacy of a large amount of illegal drugs, primarily Percocet and OxyContin. They quickly fled and a vehicular pursuit with police led into Washington, D.C., where the suspects bailed out of the stolen vehicle. Within a day, one suspect was captured and charged. The investigation continues with assistance from other jurisdictions because it is believed this group of suspects conducted other similar robberies. |
| Full Recovery 1 arrest | Cash Tracker™ - Pontiac, MI - September 11 Two suspects stole cash from a pharmacy and fled. Local police tracked and apprehended both men. All of the stolen cash was recovered. |

| \$4,184 1 arrest | Cash Tracker™ - Cleveland, OH - August 25 A lone suspect stole cash and a Cash Tracker from a pharmacy. Police used GPS tracking data from Cash Tracker to locate and apprehend the criminal. His car, which contained the tracker and the stolen cash was impounded. All of the stolen money was recovered and returned to the pharmacy. |
| \$20,000 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Vacaville, CA - August 5 Two criminals, one male and one female, carrying empty pillowcases entered a pharmacy and headed immediately to the back of the store. An alert employee noticed them and began watching...moments later, they implied weapons and jumped the pharmacy counter. Police were called just as PharmaTracker activated. Officers greeted the two robbers in the parking lot, arrested them both and recovered all of the stolen items. |
| \$55,200 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Indianapolis, IN - August 3 Two males robbed a pharmacy and stole drugs and a PharmaTracker. Police were able to track using GPS...they apprehended both suspects and they recovered all of the stolen drugs. Thanks to PharmaTracker, over 6,900 narcotic pills were kept off the street. |
| \$20,000 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - La Plata, MD - July 18 Three suspects robbed a pharmacy. PharmaTracker alerted police and they began tracking. One suspect was apprehended quickly and police used air support to search for the other two. This robbery may be linked to the July 16th pharmacy robbery in Greenbelt, MD. |
| \$20,000 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Greenbelt, MD - July 16 A pharmacy was robbed and the suspect was given a PharmaTracker. After traveling through multiple jurisdictions, police were able to apprehend the suspect and recover all of the stolen drugs. Police believe the suspect may have ties to a group responsible for pharmacy robberies in Maryland, Virginia and Washington, DC. Additional arrests are anticipated. |
| \$40,000 | PharmaTracker® - Sterling Heights, MI - July 8 Four criminals wearing masks burglarized a neighborhood pharmacy at around 4:30 a.m. They were able to steal the entire 500 lb. safe containing the prescription drugs. Luckily, the pharmacy had placed a PharmaTracker inside so police were notified of the burglary and started tracking. Once the police started tailing the suspects, they accelerated reaching speeds up to 100 mph. The weight of the safe broke the tailgate and the safe fell out so police were able to recover all of the stolen drugs as well as the minimally-damaged safe. |
| \$7,000 3 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Indianapolis, IN - June 27 Three suspects robbed a pharmacy of narcotics and fled by vehicle. Police tracked with GPS and when the suspects became stationary, police moved in. A full recovery was made and the suspects are behind bars. The suspects are wanted for another pharmacy robbery in June. |
| \$20,000 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Lexington, SC - June 24 A disguised male approached a pharmacist, implied a weapon, and demanded all the OxyContin. The pharmacist complied and the suspect fled on foot into a wooded area. PharmaTracker silently alerted police who tracked. A full recovery was made and the suspect is behind bars. |

| \$20,000 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Greenbelt, MD - June 17 A lone suspect robbed a pharmacy of narcotics and fled the store. PharmaTracker alerted police who tracked and apprehended the suspect. All the narcotics were recovered. |
| \$20,000 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Colton, CA - June 16 Two suspects burglarized a pharmacy and fled by vehicle at speeds in excess of 120 mpg. Police tracked and when the suspects became stationary, police moved in. All the stolen narcotics were recovered and the two suspects are behind bars. |
| \$1,641 2 arrests | Cash Tracker™ - Cleveland, OH - June 2 Two suspects entered a pharmacy and demanded cash. Cash Tracker automatically notified police who tracked and apprehended the suspects. A full recovery was made. |
| \$20,000 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Madera, CA - May 25 Two suspects broke into a pharmacy and stole narcotics. PharmaTracker automatically alerted police who began tracking. The suspects fled, driving erratically and at a high rate of speed, so police pulled back and tracked at a safe distance. When the suspects lost control of their vehicle, police moved in. Both suspects are behind bars and a full recovery was made. |
| \$20,000 3 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Scranton, PA - May 21 Three robbers entered a pharmacy, demanded narcotics and fled by vehicle. Police tracked and made a felony stop before the suspects entered the interstate. A full recovery was made and the three suspects are behind bars. |
| \$20,000 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Edmonton, AB - May 13 A male suspect, armed with a knife, forced a pharmacist to open the store's safe. The suspect stole 49 bottles of narcotics, cash and lottery tickets. PharmaTracker notified police who tracked the suspect to a bus terminal. The suspect was apprehended on a bus and a full recovery was made. |
| \$3,000 5 arrests | Cash Tracker™ - Jacinto City, TX - Apr 14 One adult female and four juvenile males robbed a pharmacy of cash at gunpoint. Police were silently alerted and began to track. When the suspects became stationary, police moved in. The five suspects were apprehended and all the stolen cash was recovered in a suspect's backpack. |
| \$45,000 5 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Memphis, TN - Apr 27 Five suspects robbed a pharmacy and then drove to an apartment building. Police tracked with GPS and secured the area. Five suspects were apprehended and firearms and narcotics from this and other robberies were recovered inside the apartment. |
| \$25,600 1 arrest | PharmaTracker® - Minneapolis, MN - Mar 28 Two suspects robbed a pharmacy late in the evening. Police were alerted and tracked with GPS. One suspect was apprehended and a full recovery was made. |

| \$20,000 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - London, ON - Feb 17 Two suspects robbed a pharmacy of a large amount of narcotics. PharmaTracker alerted police who quickly tracked and apprehended the suspects. A full recovery was made. |
| \$20,000 2 arrests | PharmaTracker® - Hamilton, ON - Jan 29 Two suspects robbed a pharmacy and fled to a residence where they became stationary. PharmaTracker alerted police who tracked. Officers from several agencies surrounded the residence and took the suspects into custody. All the stolen narcotics were recovered. |
